Our topics for this term are Fairytales & Farm Animals. We will be looking at well known fairytales, using adjectives to describe the characters, baking our favourite 'The Gingerbread Man' and enhancing our writing and drawing skills through drawing club.

In Maths our we will be cementing our number knowledge to 5 and moving on to look at numbers to 10. We will be subitising, exploring odd & even numbers, doubling and halving. We will also be exploring mass & capacity, length, height and time and starting to differentiate between 2D & 3D shapes.

The Rocket Phonics scheme will be moving onto red sounds but we will keep revisiting our pink sounds to keep these embedded.

It is encouraged to listen to your child read as much as possible, as they love sharing their stories with you! It has been great to see so many children receiving their Rainbow Readers certificates.

PE this term will continue to be on a Thursday afternoon with Mr Grant.

The children will also have plenty of time to explore both inside and outside, building on their social skills and independent learning.
